Dear friends,



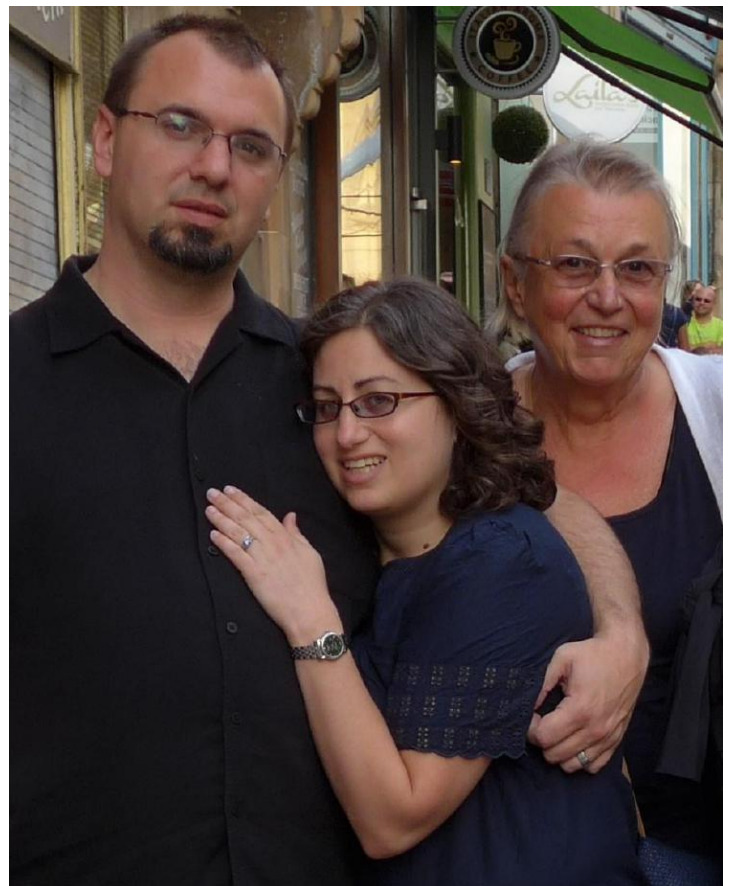
It has been 3 years now, since Diether has retired and we have left the San Francisco Bay Area. We find, that we are enjoying ourselves more than ever.
